COVID-19 AUDITION AND REHEARSAL PROTOCOLS

Lost Baggage Musical Theatre has always prioritized the safety of our patrons, cast, and crew members. In response to COVID-19, we have been following regional guidelines that are in place and taking additional safety precautions. Below is a listing of these precautions, which were made in accordance with the Province of Ontario's document entitled, "Workplace Safety and Prevention Services Guidance on Health and Safety for Television, Film, and Live Performance Sector During COVID-19".

AUDITION PROTOCOLS

- All those at the audition must adhere to social distancing
- All those at the audition must sign-in and declare that they have 1) not be experiencing and COVID-19 symptoms, 2) have remained in Canada for the last fourteen days, and 3) not have come into contact with someone who has COVID-19 or is experiencing any COVID-19 symptoms
- All high-contact surfaces/areas and audition equipment (tables, instruments...) must be sanitized before and after auditions begin
- Anyone entering the audition location must sanitize their hands before entering (LBMT will provide hand sanitizer) and have a face mask with them (face masks do not need to be worn outdoors, indoors only)
- Auditions should be done outdoors (or in a large, well ventilated area)
- Auditions must be scheduled in a way that those auditioning do not come in contact with each other
- Any equipment used during auditions must be sanitized in between auditions (chairs, music stands...)
- Audition forms will be sent in advance electronically
- Any sides or music needed for the audition will be printed for each individual person (no sharing)
- Gloves will be provided for those who want to use them

REHEARSAL PROTOCOLS

- All those at rehearsals must adhere to social distancing
- Closer to show dates, social distancing rules may be broken (only for cast members who are rehearsing specific parts of the actual show) as per the directing team and the comfort levels of the cast and crew
- All those at the rehearsal must sign-in and declare that they have 1) not be experiencing and COVID-19 symptoms, 2) have remained in Canada for the last fourteen days, and 3) not have come into contact with someone who has COVID-19 or is experiencing any COVID-19 symptoms
- All high-contact surfaces and areas must be sanitized before and after rehearsals begin
- All props, set pieces, and equipment (chairs, instruments...) must be sanitized before the start of the rehearsal
- Anyone entering the rehearsal location must 1) sanitize their hands before entering (LBMT will provide a hand-washing station with antibacterial soap and/or hand sanitizer), 2) have already signed a LBMT COVID-19 waiver form, and 3) have a face mask with them
- For rehearsals that are over two hours long, hands and props/set pieces will need to be washed and sanitized part-way through the rehearsal process
- Rehearsals should be done outdoors (or in a large, well ventilated area)
- Any scripts or music needed will be printed for each individual person (no sharing)
- Gloves will be provided for those who want to use them
